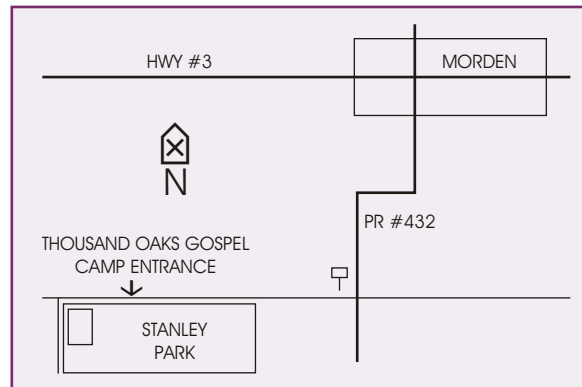

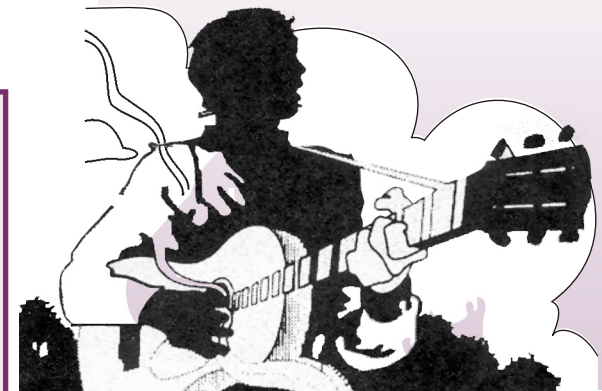

Doctrinal Statement

We believe... in one, triune God - the Father, Son and Holy Spirit and that the scriptures of the Old and New Testaments are inspired by God.. ...that God's Word is accurate, and that it contains all truth necessary to live a faithful and Christian life.

...that all people are born in sin and are hopelessly and eternally lost, but that through the crucifixion and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ the whole human race may live a victorious life in eternity. ...that whosoever repents and believes in the Lord Jesus Christ is justified, regenerated and saved from the control of sin and eternal suffering.

...in the necessity of heart holiness and the dedication of believers through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ.

...that the Holy Spirit bears witness to our spirit, that we are the sons and daughters of God and that He hears and answers prayer.

...Finally, we believe in the coming return of our Lord, in the resurrection of the dead and in the final judgement.

We also believe... ...that marriage is a lifelong union ordained of God in which a man and a woman of like mind, faith and fellowship are united in the Lord in Holy Matrimony. (Mark 10:9-12; 1 Cor.7:39; Eph.5:21-33; Col.3:18-19)

...that divorce and remarriage of divorced people are a violation of Jesus' commands, and contribute to the moral breakdown of society. (Matth.19:3-9; John 8:1-11)

...the biblical view of sex firmly establishes it within the framework of marriage and family life. Therefore, we cannot condone premarital sex, adultery, or any form of homosexual behavior. (1 Cor.6:9-10; Rom.1:20-32; Deut. 22:23-27)

...Christians should make their external appearance conform to the divine nature which the Holy Spirit has placed on them. (1 Tim.2:8-10)

...That Christians give a clear testimony against wearing of anything that offends good taste or is otherwise unbecoming for the child of God. (1 Cor. 11:2-16)
